Those companies that can translate their strategy into measurement system will be able to execute their strategy because they communicate their objectives and their targets. The communication

makes managers and employees focus on the critical drivers enabling them to align investments, initiatives and actions accomplishing strategic goals.

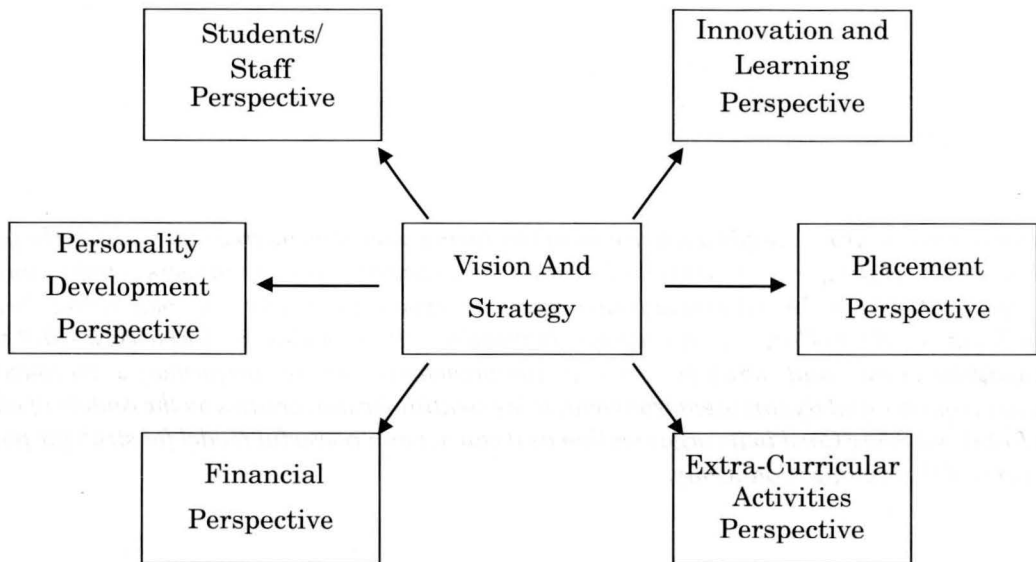
